

## Address by Bishop Tutai Pere, Chair of the Seabed Minerals Advisory Committee at the Exploration Licence Granting Ceremony 2022

Turou, Kia Orana tatou katoatoa I te aroa mata o tatou Atua.

Greetings and welcome to everyone who patiently sat in for this jam-packed, interesting, historic milestone event for the Cook Islands. Congratulations. Those on live-stream, far and near, we embrace you with the love of our Lord and Saviour Jesus. Being the last speaker I feel a huge sigh of relief. Everyone eager for a quick break; for a cup of tea, coffee and lunch.

Early this morning, I couldn't help but email to my commissioner, Alex Herman, and commend her and congratulate her for wonderful work that she and her team has done. I named her this morning as the 'Esther' of the Seabed, Cook Islands.

Not forgetting of course the first SBM Commissioner, Paul Lynch. 2013, we had the first advisory board, 2019, the current advisory board. You are the 'Mordecai' of that advisory board that brought us this far. On that note, and for the same token, each and every man and woman that has been involved in the Seabed Minerals Authority, since the very beginning until today, we are the Mordecai's and Esther's of the Seabed Minerals Authority of the Cook Islands, because we have laid our heads down for the salvation, and for the prosperity, and also the future success of seabed mining for the Cook Islands.

Let me start with a short Cook Island saying: "Te Ulu o te Akauroa, Ka oki rai kite Akauroa." This is the short sight vision, where we think this 'Akauroa' refers to the Aitutaki reef. To Au'Au Enua, Ngaputoru, or Pa Enua Tokerau, that's a short sight vision. This 'Akauroa' where the fish will go back for food sources in the 'Akauroa' extends 200 nautical miles in our Marae Moana. And I'm happy to see our Ambassador for the Marae Moana, Kevin Iro, with us this afternoon. Let's acknowledge him, and his team.

To begin with, Charles Dickens in his most famous novel 'Tale of Two Cities' open up his storyline with his most historically popular and famous statement: "It was the best of times, and it was the worst of times." As of yesterday, five million, nine hundred six thousand five hundred eighty already dead of COVID specifically. Throughout the many months of vigilant and diligent assessment, evaluation, screening process have already shown and positively proven not as novices and amateurs in the business but have had decades of practical exercises and experiences with total confidence in what they are capable of doing.

Many who have turned into mighty rich affluent and wealthy super rich power countries of the world today have all had their turns of mining, harvesting and extracting all kinds of any God-given natural resources but many sadly and very unfortunately out of much greed abuse and exploitations of wealth have turned into hungry money mongering tycoons but leaving behind in their very own backyards trails of millions upon millions of the world's population living under the poverty line dying of malnutrition, disease, homelessness, uncontrollable innocent human lives lost in wars, abortion, crimes of abuse and violence and the rest.
